How exciting that Kevin Wright will be joining us as part of the ministry team here. This is the result of a long prayerful period of searching with several detours along the way. After our youth minister left in summer 2008, that fall we began a search for an associate minister. The elders received resumes, conducted interviews, and had at least three candidates visit us, but none of those worked out.

For over a year, our youth ministry functioned with youth interns, parent volunteers and various teachers, while I taught the High School Bible Class at the academy. Last summer we were able to hire a youth minister, but that also turned out to be a detour. Now we have an excellent youth intern in Chris Langley and also have other youth interns interested in this ministry when Chris graduates. Kevin's hire reflects the goal we have been seeking for a year and a half.

Most of you know that I asked for a decreased obligation last fall and the elders graciously granted my request to go to 80% (with a corresponding reduction in remuneration). I have communicated to the elders my desire to redefine my role in 2011 (after my 62nd birthday late in 2010).

As the elders announced Sunday, we do not know exactly what the ministry will look like in the immediate future. I am sure Kevin and I will work together closely in 2010 in all aspects of ministry, especially in education, small groups, and sermons. A major advantage of this time of shared ministry will be the opportunity to cement the team by letting us get to know one another better. During the transition, the role I will assume in 2011 will also be defined.

Thank you for your kind words and constant support as we share the spiritual journey together.

Bob has expressed an interest in transitioning into a different role at Main and Oklahoma in late 2010 and we are excited at the prospects of such a move. We truly believe that the addition of Kevin and the development of this role with Bob is a "win-win" for this congregation and for the cause of Christ in McAlester and Pittsburg County. We solicit your prayers and welcome your comments and questions as we undergo this transition.
