**bits from bob...**

Jan and I enjoyed tremendously the opportunity to teach and preach at the Northwest church in OKC last Sunday, but we always miss you when we not "at home." Our reception at Northwest was delightful—the church is anticipating a \$100,000 contribution for their 2010 missions program on the first Sunday in March. Major parts of their mission program are centered in Guyana, Greece, and Israel. We appreciate opportunities to be away and assist with the advance of the cause of Christ in various places around the world. As you graciously give us these opportunities, you also help advance the gospel.

Thank you for your kind reception on Sunday evening to the first in a short OT series. The first seven books of the OT cover the time period from the creation to the time of the kings of Israel (about 1000 BC). The general theme for the series centers on the choices we make (Genesis—blessing, Exodus—freedom, Leviticus—holiness, Numbers—obedience, Deuteronomy—life, Joshua—service, and Judges—victory). Along the way, we will notice many other significant themes.

In Genesis, we come face to face with the powerful word of God. God by his word speaks **creation** into being. God answers to no one higher, and thus what he says is guaranteed as reality. When God **blesses**, none can contradict him. The **promises** of God are certain. In words, God **reveals** himself and communicates the **assurance** of his continuing presence. **This creating, blessing, promising, revealing, assuring word of God is much more than what we often think of when we consider the Word of God.** The word of God in Genesis is the same word of truth we encounter in the NT—a word which does much more in our lives and in our world than save.

With Easter only a little over a month away, this coming Sunday morning we will begin a sermon series which will climax in early April. All of these sermons come from the New Testament and are part of a sermon series I have developed in the last few months for use in special campaigns, gospel series, and revivals. (I am working also on a Spanish translation of these sermons.) This would be an excellent time to invite friends, relatives, associates, and neighbors. Following is the general outline of the series. The last sermon in the series is delayed one week because current plans call for Shawn Gary to be here and preach on Easter.

- February 21 God Reveals his Plan (Gospels)
- February 28 Good News of Re-Creation (Acts)
- March 5 Rebirth and Renewal through the Spirit (Romans)
- March 12 Really New through Reconciliation (Paul's letters)
- March 19 Authentic Discipleship: Living in Reverse (Luke)
- March 26 God Makes Us Righteous (John)
- April 11 Resurrected to Live "Anew" (Revelation)

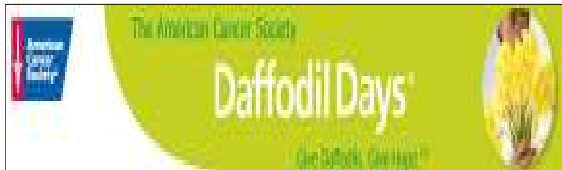
In the next few weeks, I will begin video-recording a fifth lesson series for New Life Behavior. This will make 66 lessons that I have recorded for use in the prison work. NLB makes about 400-500 copies of each lesson to be distributed to students who attend the classes. The videos can also be used on the prison TV systems in some facilities. You can do the math—the first use of the videos in classes reaches at least 25000-30000 viewers.

Last week I received a report from Ambassadors for Christ with an update concerning the use and success of the eight Bible study lessons I translated into Spanish for them. The lessons are being used with great success and much enthusiasm in various places across the US and in other countries. I share this good news to say "thank you" for the ministry you enable.

Remember our 2010 theme—go forth to be a blessing, wherever, whenever, and for whomever God allows!
