bits from bob... **SMALL GROUPS RESUME SEPTEMBER 20**



You have been asking for several weeks—here is the answer!
Our small groups resume on September 20! Please note the following details.

- *We will use the same groups that formed and met from January-June of this year. (Each of these groups has an elder in it, but the intention is not that the elders necessarily be the group leaders. Each group should select its own leaders.)
- *This Sunday, September 13, you will have an opportunity to change groups if you wish. All group lists will be available in the foyer. To change groups, mark through your name and initial in your current group listing, and write your name in the new group listing.
- *All members are encouraged to sign up and participate in a group, but the group listings available this Sunday will not include members who seldom attend.
- *This will allow fringe members to be included in our fellowship through natural relationships and bridges, with invitations to attend multiple groups.
- *The small groups will meet throughout the school year (until May 2010).
- *Groups will generally meet twice each month (1st and 3rd Sunday evenings) at 6:00 p.m. after evening worship. (Our experience over the last year indicates that monthly meetings are too infrequent, and that weekly meetings are too often.)
- *Groups may add more meetings, but we ask groups to meet during the scheduled times.
- *There will be discussion resources available for each group meeting, but the group leaders will determine the activities for their group meetings. For example, groups may choose to share a meal or not.
- *The theme of this year's small groups is "Touching Hearts, Transforming Lives".
- *The small group discussion resources will not be connected to the evening worship or introduced in the shared worship at the building. Discussion materials will be available one week in advance, at the building and online.
- *The purpose of our small groups is to provide deeper fellowship opportunities and to provide smaller fellowship settings where friends, family, and neighbors can experience life in this church family in a non-threatening environment.
- *Groups may want to consider how various aspects of our shared congregational life (for example, worship, prayer, singing, study, fellowship, and sharing needs) can be incorporated into the group meetings.
